Your Waterfront Committee has developed an online orientation program to ensure that all Club Members understand and are compliant with the essential steps in operating the Club's cranes.

Effective June 1st, 2015, members who have not completed the online instructional session will no longer be permitted to use the cranes. Members are encouraged to share this presentation with individuals who may be assisting them with crane use. *Please note: raising or lowering the gaff on the spar crane requires a Min of 2 persons.*
