



The Iles de la Madeleine Highlights

Departure at 8:45 a.m. Returning at 17h30 p.m.

This tour brings you to the villages of Cap Aux Meules, Étang du Nord, Fatima Havre-aux-Maisons, Pointe-aux-Loups, Grosse Ile and Grande-Entrée and includes the following visits:

Visit the church in Lavernière Constructed in 1876, it is the second largest wooden church in North America. It constitutes a major element of the madelinot heritage, being classified as a historical monument since 1992.

Visit the Fumoir d'antan (Smokehouse) of the numerous fishing buildings, the most typical remains the smokehouse. We still see a few of these exceptional constructions of years ago close to certain fishing harbours. The most beautiful example is that of Pointe-Basse in Havre-aux-Maisons. This smokehouse was renovated to relive this important activity from about thirty years ago. A guided visit, as well as a tasting, will allow you to discover a traditional smokehouse.

Cross the Chemin des Montants You will discover a small valley with a few houses, from where you will see one of the most beautiful panoramic view of Havre-aux-Maisons. A little further along we will see the south dune, as well as the grooves left in the sand dunes caused by the sea and the winds.

Visit South Dune Beach This extraordinary beach spreads over more than 22 km in length. You will be able to go for a walk through its amazing red sandstone underground caves, sculpted naturally by the sea.

Lunch at the Vieux Couvent a well-known institution. Freshly renovated. Impressive sight upon Havre-aux-Maisons landscapes and sunsets. A relaxed atmosphere. Comfortable cuisine that emerges from the best ingredients the Islands terroir has to propose. Several choices of meal will be offered to you.

Visit the Grande-Entrée harbour with more than 125 lobster fishers, we uncover the largest fishing harbour in the archipelago.

Visit the Fromagerie Pied de Vent (Cheese factory) an artisan factory of raw milk cheese. Produced here, among others, the "Pied de Vent", the famous cheese with slightly washed crust and the "Tomme des Demoiselles", a dough of 6 months of refinement.

Visit the Belle Anse With its steep cliffs, the Belle Anse is one of the most beautiful sightseeing points on the red sandstone cliffs. Situated on the north side of the islands, it shows us the effects of erosion in the archipelago, year after year.
