

# RNSYS J22 Protocol

## Senior and Privileged Crew Members

Ver 2.1

### Senior, Intermediate & Student Members

1. J22s are booked out for up to a 4 hour period for any day of the week between the hours of 10:00 and 21:00 (or dusk if earlier).
2. Member agrees to waiver online at time of booking.
3. The J22 is checked out prior to booking time by RNSYS staff who will note any issues. Completed pdf and pics (if applicable) emailed to member. Zip tie placed on mainsheet to indicate boat is ready.
4. Member to check boat prior to using to ensure it agrees with form. Any issues to be emailed to staff **prior** to the use of the boat.
5. Limited to a total crew of 4 persons (minimum 2 people).
6. White sail only.
7. Member in charge must have a PCOC card as a minimum and know how to sail a small keelboat.
8. Geographic sailing limit is the Northwest Arm and Halifax Harbour (from the MacDonald Bridge south to Lighthouse Bank and Eastern Passage as far as AutoPort).
9. No landing at any dock except for departure/arrival point from the RNSYS.
10. Must have a cell phone and be available for contact by RNSYS staff at all times. VHF is also recommended.
11. Must provide own Personal Flotation Device (PFD) or lifejackets for all crew.
12. After use the boat will be checked by RNSYS staff. Discrepancies will be noted and if there is damage or issues, the repairs and labour will be charged in their entirety to the member's account.
13. Member to remove all garbage and personal gear, tie up the boat properly, roll and stow the sails inside the boat and leave the boat in the same condition that they found it.
14. Member to pump the bilge if necessary.
15. Boat must be left in ready-to-sail condition.



### **For Privileged Crew**

All protocols in place for Senior members apply with the exception that:

16. Only one guest is permitted, all other sailors must be RNSYS members.

### **For Wednesday Night Races**

Members are able to reserve a J22 to compete in Wednesday Night Racing, all protocols apply with the additions below:

17. Spinnaker and lines added to sail inventory, removed before next use.
18. Members cannot specify which J22 they would like to sail.
19. Member to provide VHF for race communications.
