Fees

The RNSYS Race Team is partially subsidized by the membership of RNSYS as well as supported by sponsors.

Race Team Registration Fees for Winter Events:

At RNSYS we charge an initial fee that you will pay through clubspot in advance of the program occurring. This fee will cover the following:

- Coach Salary
- Use of RNSYS coach boat & transportation cost of RNSYS coach boat to events
- Coaching educational equipment
- 50% of the expected event expenses which includes the following:
 - Coach travel and accommodation expenses
 - Coach regatta registration
 - Site storage of boats/trailers
 - o Any other overall team expenses for events

Following the event the difference between the 50% of expected expenses and the actual expenses for the event will be billed to each participant. There will be a deadline for this fee to be paid for each event.

Race Team Registration Fees do NOT include the following:

Sailor accommodation & travel

Regatta registration fees

Race Team Trailering Fees:

If you would like your boat transported on the RNSYS trailer to Florida for the winter training camps the cost will be \$1,250 CAD for the round trip to Florida and back to Halifax. This fee includes the following:

- Transportation of boat from RNSYS to Florida in early November
- Transportation of boat from Florida to RNSYS in mid-March
- Storage costs between events in Florida over the winter
- Trailering costs between events in Florida over the winter

Minimums:

All winter events are subject to a minimum registration. The registration fees listed below are based on minimum registrations - if more sailors sign up the event becomes cheaper for all sailors. If we do not meet the minimum registration required we will make every effort to find alternative coaching opportunities for those sailors who are signed up.

Events

South Carolina Yacht Club Team-Racing Invitational Regatta

About: This event is by invitation only and RNSYS is extremely pleased to be invited back for another year this should be an exciting event where the sailors will have an opportunity to hone and develop their team-racing skills and to represent their yacht club.

US Sailing ODP Camp

About: This event is a national talent identification camp for US Sailing which Canadians are welcome to attend. This is a top-level training event with some of the best coaches from across the USA in attendance. It is an excellent opportunity for ILCA and 29er sailors to develop skills and learn from some of the best.

Orange Bowl

About: Orange Bowl is a premier event held every year at the Coral Reef Yacht Club in Miami. This is a very well-attended regatta with dozens to hundreds of sailors attending depending on the class of boat. This is an excellent opportunity for sailors to gain experience sailing against some of the top sailors in North America and in larger fleets. Registration for Orange Bowl Opens on September 11. Pre-Orange Bowl Training: Train with the RNSYS team from December 18-22 at Coral Reef Yacht Club in preparation for this event. The cost for the training block will be \$750/person. The registration minimum for the pre-Oragne Bowl Training is 5 Optis.

Canadian Sailing Youth Squad Trails

About: This is a selection camp for the Canadian Sailing Youth Squad - Sail Canada's national youth training group/team of identified athletes. This event is by invitation only - sailors must be identified and invited to the camp by Sail Canada at one of the various domestic talent identification camps.

Notes: As soon as we have confirmation of identified sailors from RNSYS, location, and dates we will communicate on how RNSYS can support attending sailors individually.

International Sailing Week - Mar Del Plata, Argentina - Pre-Worlds Champs Regatta

About:

Training and competition with over 450 sailors from around the world at the 2024 IODA World Championships Venue! Race against the top sailors in the world. Many top Teams are using this event to train for the 2024 Optimist World Championship. Like the USA, Italy, Europian, North American, Central and South American countries, and others. It will be run using the same Worlds Champs format with a Fleet Racing Regatta and a high-level Team racing Regatta.

This opportunity is specifically for those sailors who placed in the top 15 of Opti Canadians this past summer and will be coached by RNSYS Head Opti Race Coach Maru Ferrarrio.

This event will have heavy wind and big waves which will help prepare the sailors for any of the IODA events they will be attending in 2024. Many of the 2024 IODA events are run in heavy wind places so this regatta is an ideal opportunity for the sailors to prepare for it. The regatta also offers a 'Regatta hotel' for all the international Teams. It will be run very similar to an IODA event. A perfect opportunity for all those sailors who qualified for any 2024 international events to experience, warm up, and get used to racing at IODA regattas.

Parent Support

Parent support is a key pillar of the program. Because our program has very limited resources and we work hard to get the most out of them, we rely on EVERY parent for extra support to the team. It is that

extra support from the parents that makes a difference. We are very fortunate to have such a fantastic program thanks to all the parents who put great extra effort into supporting the team.

Chaperones for Away Events

There must be a chaperone on every trip! When traveling with minors, a coaching figure, as well as a supporting adult figure, is needed for team success. Those two figures cannot fall on the same person. The chaperone or Parent On Duty is a great source of support for the coach and sailors during a trip and ultimately the responsible adult in charge of the underage members of the team.

Please note that when sending your sailor on a trip on their own, you are accepting the chaperoning style & living rules of the adult supervising your kid.

It is up to the parents of sailors attending to determine if they wish to travel with their sailors or send their sailors with the chaperone. It is up to the group of parents attending the event to confirm who they want to be the chaperone and make those arrangements for their own sailors.

Event Communications

Once RNSYS has received registrations for events our program management team will follow up with a formal email regarding all the details of the event. Parents of sailors will then be added to a Whatsapp chat for communications regarding the event as we lead up to the event. Some of the events do not have the Notice of Race or event website set up yet as these become available we will communicate to the attending sailors.
